## applications

#### 1. Applications as speakers

People interested in presenting their research can send the advanced draft of their papers, in English or Spanish, to <u>mvaldivi@uahurtado.cl</u>before December 30, 2022. The document should have between 5 thousand and 10 thousand words. The title of the paper can be tentative and you must indicate which panel you would like to integrate. In the first footnote, the contact information, institutional affiliation and studies or academic degrees must be mentioned. Undergraduate students who are working on their theses or final cycle, postgraduate students, researchers and teachers may apply. The Scientific Committee will report the results before January 10, 2023. The papers that are selected will be part of a collective book on Critical Theory of Law and Social Justice in the Americas, which will be published in 2023.

#### 2. Applications as participants or assistants

People interested in applying as assistants must register in the <u>registration form</u>, before December 20, 2022, and must upload the following documents to the form: 1) a certificate that certifies the completion of university studies (for example, a copy of of the degree or highest academic degree achieved, or, document that accredits the

quality of university student in an undergraduate career in any university or establishment of higher education in the American continent; 2°) your updated curriculum vitae, and 3°) a motivation letter (maximum 750 words) in which you explain your interests and reasons for applying to the course. The course contemplates the participation of a maximum of 120 people. If you have any doubts or queries, write to<u>vinculacionderecho@uahurtado.cl.</u>

The list of selected people will be informed on December 20, 2022 -limited places-. Participating in the Summer Course has no cost, since the objective of the organizing institutions is to support people interested in expanding their knowledge.

However, those selected who come from other countries and regions of Uruguay **will have to cover their travel, accommodation and food expenses**. To reduce accommodation and transfer costs for undergraduate students, the Organizing Committee has entered into an agreement with the Universitas Mercosur Apart Hotel, a ten-minute walk from the Central House of the Catholic University of Uruguay. The Organizing Committee will centralize the reservations of people interested in staying in said establishment.

100 percent attendance at course sessions will be required. The maximum professionalism and academic rigor of the participants is expected. Please keep in mind that this is an intensive course, which requires exclusive dedication. At the end of the program, a Certificate of Participation, signed by the Organizing Committee, will be delivered to those who previously pass an online evaluation carried out within a reasonable time after the end of the course, to verify an adequate understanding of the subjects and problems addressed.
